HOURS *SUBJECT TO CHANGE*

Due to ongoing staffing shortages, the days and hours noted below are subject to change. We will absolutely try our best to keep to this schedule, however, we cannot guarantee lifeguards will be on duty during your visit. If there are no lifeguards present, there will be clear signage on the Pool Front Gate; you may swim at your own risk. Please monitor your children carefully.

CHILDREN AT POOL

Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult while at the Pool Center.

DEEP END TEST

Every child under the age of 12 is required to take the deep-end test before they are permitted to swim in the deep end without an adult, even if they have passed it in previous years. Once a child has passed the test they will receive a colored wristband to be worn in the pool at all times.

LIFEGUARDS

The Pool is meant to be fun, but safety is our top priority. All Lifeguards are certified and go through CPR/AED/ Lifeguarding/First Aid. When lifeguards are on duty, there will be a minimum of two. State law requires one guard in the guard chair per every 20 people in the Family Pool. Other Lifeguard duties include greeting members, signing in members & guests, stocking towels and supporting ongoing maintenance needs across the entire pool area and locker rooms.

3 Whistles Activates Pool Emergency Action Plan
If you ever hear 3 Whistles, exit the pool immediately!

NO GUARD ON DUTY

When there are no Lifeguards on duty, all swimmers are using the Pool Facilities at their own risk. Should an emergency occur when the Lifeguards are not present, there is a red emergency phone in the wooden box to the left of the Snack Bar (Dial 911); a First Aid Kit & AED is also located to the left of the snack bar window.

GUEST POLICY

There is an \$8 guest fee for each guest. All non-immediate family members (except for grandchildren 17 and under) are considered guests. Members' children over the age of 22 are considered guests. Non-family guest limits per day are 5 on weekdays (Monday through Thursday) and 3 on weekends (Friday through Sunday). Any time you plan on bringing more than 5 guests (family/non-family), please email pool@marincountryclub.com. All guests must sign the pool waiver.

KEEP IT CLEAN

Please help us keep the pool center beautiful and remember to clean up after yourself; use waste receptacles for trash before leaving.

SAND PIT

Help keep the sand in the sand pit. Sand can be very damaging to the pools, drains and turf. Please ask your children to shake off excess sand before leaving the sand pit. Thank you!



GATE ENTRY

To open the gate, enter your five-digit Member number + 0. Sign in all Members and guests at the sign-in table at the guard tent upon entry. All members and their guests must sign the waiver at the beginning of the season.



HANDICAP GATE

The handicap gate (also available for stroller access) will only be open during Lifeguard hours. Sign-in is still required at the Lifeguard tent.



TOWEL SERVICE

Please take one towel per person. When Lifeguards are off duty, towels will be located in the locker rooms. Please place your used towels in the white bin by the locker room entrance.



LOCKER ROOMS

When Lifeguards are on duty, keys for the pool lockers are available for check-out for day use only. Please sign the key back in upon return.



NANNIES/AU PAIRS

Once the completed Nanny/Au Pair form has been turned into the Activities Director or Lifeguard office, children may be accompanied to the Club with the Nanny/Au Pair. The Nanny/Au Pair must be in direct supervision of the children at all times.



FAMILY POOL

This Pool is open to all ages and is under direct supervision of Lifeguards during Lifeguard hours.

WADING POOL

This Pool is open to children up to age 6 (unless a toddler is accompanied by an older child) and is NOT under the direct supervision of Lifeguards; therefore, children using the Wading Pool MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES.

ADULT POOL

Must be at least 18 years old - no exceptions! The Adult Pool is NOT under the direct supervision of Lifeguards.

POOL BREAKS

Pool breaks are the last 10 minutes of each hour. Breaks apply to the family and wading pools. This is a great time to encourage young children to take a restroom break!

POOL FLOTATION DEVICES

Only Coast Guard approved life jackets or wings with chest straps are permitted at the Pool. Donut, ring floats, mermaid tails and snorkels are not allowed. If a Lifeguard's vision of the bottom of the pool is compromised, they will direct you to remove an object.
